After the Mass In Coena Domini on Holy Thursday, there will be adoration so there should be silence around the Church and basement. Also, with the Solemn Liturgy of Good Friday, let us contemplate Our Lord's Sufferings and keep the silence around the Church and basement especially from Noon until the completion of the Liturgy. Children should not be outside running and making noise. The Sacred Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday & Holy Saturday are solemn days of beautiful Liturgical ceremonies.
