## Sancti et Sanctae Dei, orate pro nobis!

Feast of the Most Precious Blood of Jesus  
July 1<sup>st</sup>

This feast was instituted by Pius IX in memory of July 1, 1849, the day of the victory of the French armies over the [1848] Revolution that had driven the Pope out of Rome. It is a praiseworthy custom to recite every day in July the beautiful Litany of the Precious Blood. "Save us!" we will repeat while invoking the redeeming Blood, because "[we] were not redeemed with corruptible things, as gold and silver, ... but with the Precious Blood of the unspotted Lamb" (1 Pt. 1:17, 19). To shed one's blood for Jesus Christ or for one's fatherland is to give one's life. In shedding His Blood, Jesus gave His life so that we might have Eternal Life. At every Mass, we are present at the ineffable mystery of the transubstantiation of the wine into the Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. The chalice that the priest elevates after pronouncing the words of consecration contains the Precious Blood of the Redeemer that flowed on the Cross.
