Saint Pius X

September 3rd

The second of 10 children in a poor Italian family, Joseph Sarto became Pius X at age 68. He was one of the 20th century's greatest popes. Ever mindful of his humble origin, Pope Pius stated, "I was born poor, I lived poor, I will die poor."

In 1905, when France renounced its agreement with the Holy See and threatened confiscation of Church property if governmental control of Church affairs were not granted, Pius X courageously rejected the

On September 8, 1907, the Encyclical Pascendi Dominici Gregis (Feeding the Lord's Flock) was published against the devastating doctrines of Modernism.

Pope Pius X is perhaps best remembered for his encouragement of the frequent reception of Holy Communion, especially by children.

On the 11th anniversary of his election as pope, Europe was plunged into World War I. Pius had foreseen it, but it killed him. "This is the last affliction the Lord will visit on me. I would gladly give my life to save my poor children from this ghastly scourge." He died a few weeks after the war began and was canonized in 1954.


