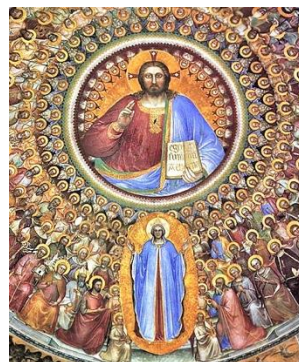
Feast of All Saints November 1

All Souls Day

Sunday, November 2nd, *will be transferred to Monday November 3rd*. The three Masses of All Souls will be at 9am and 11:15am at QHRA, and 6:00pm at SMA. Holy Communion will be offered at each Mass (please remember you can only receive once in a day). Please turn in your November 2nd tithing envelope with the names of the Poor Souls you would like to be included on the Altar for Masses in November by November 1st at the latest.

Indulgences Pertaining to the Souls in Purgatory

An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the faithful departed. The indulgence is plenary (full pardon) each day from the 1st to the 8th of November; on other days of the year, it is a partial indulgence.

Prerequisites:

1. State of Grace
2. Confession eight days before or after
3. Reception of Holy Communion on the day of
4. Complete detachment from sin, even venial sin
5. Pray for the Intentions of the Holy Father

How to gain the indulgence:

1. On November 2nd- visit a church, say vocally (at least softly audible) The Nicene Creed (the Creed that is said at Mass), the Our Father, the Hail Mary, and the Glory Be for the intentions of the Holy Father
2. On November 1st-8th –Visit a cemetery and say prayers for the Souls of the faithful departed
