**Holy Week**

*Holy Week is the most sacred time of the Liturgical Year, please keep in mind when attending the Mass and especially the Sacred Triduum. Talking around the Church should be kept to a minimum so that we can reflect on the Passion and Sufferings of Our Lord and why He suffered all of this for us. After the Mass In Coena Domini on Holy Thursday, there will be adoration so there should be silence around the Church and basement. Also, with the Solemn Liturgy of Good Friday, let us contemplate Our Lord's Sufferings and keep the silence around the Church and basement especially from Noon until the completion of the Liturgy. Children should not be outside running and making noise. The Sacred Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday & Holy Saturday are solemn days of beautiful Liturgical ceremonies.*
