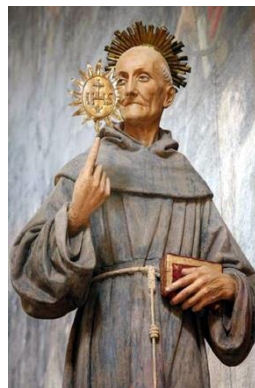

St. Bernardine of Siena

Bernardino Albizzeschi was born in Massa Marittima, some 30 miles (50km) from Siena, on September 8, 1380. Bernardine, who was to become famous as the Apostle of Italy, emulated St. Vincent in his mode of life – going from place to place to preach and convert sinners. St. Bernardine had a great devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus. He devised a symbol – IHS, the first three letters of the name of Jesus in Greek, written on a blazing sun. He had it engraved, in letters of gold, on a wooden tablet, and used to hold it up to the people after his sermons. Bernardine promoted the devotion to the Name of Jesus as a simple and effective means of recalling God's love at all times. The devotion spread, and the symbol began to appear in churches, homes and public buildings all across the country. Many miracles are attributed to St. Bernardine. He was canonized by Pope Nicholas V in 1450, only six years after his death. St. Bernardine's body, preserved incorrupt to this very day, is kept in the Basilica di San Bernardino in L'Aquila
